What is happening in History class...

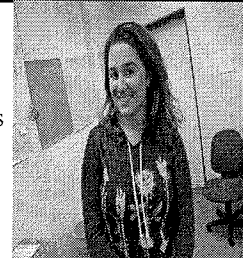

US History is diving into WWII from the US perspective. Examples such as the Attack on Pearl Harbor, D-day, Women in the work force, and the Atomic bomb.

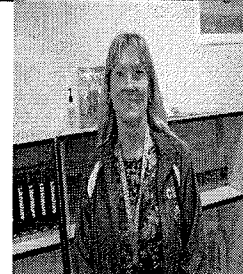
